Explore the antebellum history of the Shadows-on-the-Teche through the eyes of two women—Mary Weeks, who took over the sugar plantation’s operation after the death of her husband; and Louisa Bryant, the enslaved housekeeper who managed the day-to-day at Shadows. Delve into their lives and experiences at the Shadows, which was constructed in 1834 not as the grand plantation house, but as a family home that stood on the edge of town. Over 17,000 documents, photographs, oral histories, archaeological artifacts, and original furnishings shape the visitor’s experience. A selection of regional books and local art can be found in the museum shop.
