### **Shadows Visitor Center**

- OPEN:** Monday-Saturday from 10am to 4pm  
Guided tours begin 15 minutes after the hour. Last tour at 3:15pm.  
Self-guided tour of the gardens available.
- PARKING:** Free parking available at Shadows Visitor Center (320 E. Main St).  
Street parking available on Main Street in front of historic site.
- GUIDED TOUR:** Tour the antebellum home, furnished with original furniture from the four generations of the Weeks family to live in the home from 1834 to 1958.  
Self-guided tour of the gardens included.  
Allow 1-1.5 hours for house and gardens tour.
- SELF-GUIDED TOUR:** Tour the gardens with specialized QR (Quick Response) codes an interactive tour with additional information for an enhanced experience.
- ADMISSION:** \$10.50 adult / \$8.50 senior (65+) / \$6.75 children (6 to 17)
- GROUPS (15+):** \$8.00 adult / \$5.25 Student  
One complimentary admission per adult group. For student groups, one chaperone receives complimentary admission per every 10 paid students.  
French and English speaking tours available for groups.  
Two weeks advance notice preferred. Tours can be arranged for times beyond regular hours to accommodate tour itinerary.

Payment due upon arrival. We accept cash, Visa, Mastercard, and checks. Checks made out to: Shadows-on-the-Teche. For group tours, one payment must be submitted for all group members.
